r. Donoway is using multi-modality therapy combining Pancreatic NanoKnife Tumor Ablation with chemo-immuno-radio therapy to treat advanced-stage cancer patients worldwide after they have stopped responding to the standard of care therapy and have been left with few options for further treatment.







A Century of Faith and Blessings



he year 2025 marks the 100th Anniversary of the First Presbyterian Church of Hollywood and its celebration of "A Century of Faith and Blessings." As we commemorate our history and the blessings bestowed upon our spiritual home, we respectfully honor our founders and leaders, recognizing their prowess and unwavering dedication

to establishing our wonderful Church and excellent school, where everyone is Invited, Welcomed, and Loved.

Founded in 1925, the congregation first met in the old Hollywood Central School Building. In 1934, a building from North Miami Beach was relocated to our Hollywood Boulevard prop-

erty on the west

side of 16th Avenue and converted into our first sanctuary. Following that, the Woman's Group of First Presbyterian proudly raised \$600 to purchase the property on the east side of 16th Avenue. In 1948, the Church built its present sanctuary on this location.

Upon the opening of the new sanctuary, the Church moved the temporary structure from the west side of 16th Avenue to Ojus in North Miami to serve another church. In 1954, First Presbyterian

built a new educational center on the original church site. Over time, as the church facility evolved, the educational center also grew. That initial building became the first of three schools, which now span two campuses. Two of the buildings are on the main campus beginning at the southwest corner of 16th Avenue, and along with the well-known "Pumpkin Patch".

"Pumpkin Patch", stretch along Hollywood Boulevard to 17th Avenue. The third school is located in Hollywood Hills on Wilson Street on the St. James Campus.

HOLLYWOOD HISTORICAL SOCIETY'S INAUGURAL HISTORIC HUNT AND DISCO BALL A SMASHING SUCCESS!

A Day of Discovery, Dancing, and Decades of History

On February 22, Hollywood's past came alive in a citywide celebration unlike any other. As part of the city's Centennial Celebration, the Hollywood Historical Society (HHS) transformed Hollywood into a life-sized game board, challenging participants with a historic scavenger hunt spanning all six city districts.

Then, as the sun set, the party shifted gears—and decades! The grounds of the Hammerstein House, home to the HHS, transported guests back to the 1970s with a dazzling Disco Ball featuring a DJ, a glowing dance floor, delicious food, drinks, and shopping. The evening proved that history and fun make the perfect duo!

Hunting Down the Past

"We had multiple goals with the History Hunt," explained Andy Ruffner, executive director of the Historical Society. "We wanted to work closely with the city, get new people of all ages interested in the city's history, of course, have fun, and most importantly, make sure that people know that our reach clearly extends to all corners of the city."

More than a dozen teams took on the challenge, racing against the clock to locate six historic sites within two hours. The hunt kicked off at City Hall, where Mayor Josh Levy flagged teams off with a set of cryptic clues leading them to iconic locations.

The sites—one in each district—were manned by the district's commissioner and an HHS director, who shared fascinating historical insights with participants.

At the start of the Disco Ball, winning teams were awarded valuable prizes, all generously donated by local Hollywood businesses.

Dancin' Back in Time

As '70s music filled the air and neon lights illuminated the dance floor, the Hammerstein House (1520 Polk Street) became a disco dream. The property was alive with vendors, food trucks, drink stations, and an enthusiastic crowd, many dressed in full disco regalia.

"The dance floor and its surrounds were full all night, until the music ended," reported attendees, who traveled from as far as New York and Canada—and as close as just across the alley—to take part in this unforgettable event.

The day wasn't just about fun—it was also a financial success for the HHS, an impressive feat for a first-time event. Several board members confirmed their excitement for the future, stating that they "fully intend to make history repeat itself next year with a second annual Hollywood Historical Society Historic Hunt and Disco Ball."

Keeping Hollywood's History Alive

This exciting event was just a glimpse of the Hollywood Historical Society's mission to preserve and share the city's rich history with current and future generations.






THE HIDDEN COST OF BACKYARD BREEDING: Gia's Story

ia, a young puppy with a severe disability, was abandoned at the Humane Society by backyard breeders—just hours from euthanasia. Born with bilateral patellar luxation, her knees are permanently dislocated, and her condition is worsening. Without urgent surgery, she faces a life of pain and limited mobility.

When Atlanta Boeri learned of Gia's



fate, she couldn't turn away. In September, she signed paperwork to pull her from the non-adoptable list. Now 11 months old, Gia faces months of surgeries and recovery. Her family canceled their summer vacation to care for her, choosing compassion over convenience.


Gia's case highlights a larger issue: backyard breeders dumping unsellable dogs at shelters. Many of these animals require costly medical care, shifting the burden to shelters and rescues. While these actions are recorded, little is done to regulate the businesses responsible. Volunteers say authorities are often unable—or unwilling—to intervene.

Public awareness is key to change. If enforcement agencies won't act, public pressure might. Stronger oversight and accountability are needed to prevent more animals like Gia from being abandoned.

Gia is getting a second chance—but many others won't. Addressing this issue requires community involvement and advocacy. Together, we can push for better regulations and ensure that no more dogs are discarded when they are no longer profitable.

RED FLAG WARNINGS

What Residents Need to Know

s dry conditions and strong winds persist, the National Weather Service (NWS) has issued Red Flag Warnings throughout South Florida, including Weston and surrounding areas. 
