Traveling the World in One Day

Traveling around the world in a single day may sound impossible — but in Weston, it became a joyful reality. The 11th annual Weston World Fest, organized by the Arts Council of Greater Weston in collaboration with the City of Weston, was an extraordinary success this year, transforming the city into a vibrant celebration of art, culture, music, and global traditions. For one unforgettable day, thousands of residents and visitors gathered to see, hear and taste the world.

From the moment the Cypress Bay Marching Band opened the festivities at noon, the energy was electric. The audience

enjoyed a full afternoon of music and dance performances from talented cultural groups representing traditions from around the world. In addition to perennial favorites like the Ukrainian Dancers of Miami to the first-time appearances of Flamenco Spanish dance and a Colombian cultural dance group, it showcased our community's cultural history. One performer remarked, "Weston is a place where people of so many different backgrounds share their individual origins and they truly flourish."

The festival was also a feast for the palate. Visitors enjoyed a wide variety of international cuisine from South America to Eastern Europe. Where else could you find an artisan German pretzel, just steps away from a French crepe, followed by a traditional Ukrainian dessert paired with freshly brewed Colombian coffee? It made for a gastronomic bridge that united all attendees.

This year's event featured a record 24 country booths, each with authentic decorations, traditional clothing, and inter-

active experiences prepared by dozens of community volunteers. The 2026 festival theme, "Bridges Across the Waters," was also brought to life in the Theme Village, where children and adults could write their wishes and attach them to symbolic bridges inspired by Budapest, Brooklyn, and China. Visitors carried festival passports, collecting stamps from different countries as they explored cultures from around the globe.

"It felt like traveling the world with my kids without leaving Weston," one visitor shared. "Every booth had something new to learn, taste, or experience. Their participation created a vibrant atmosphere where education, culture, and community engagement came together."

As the sun began to set and the final performance concluded, the smiles across the park said it all. Weston World Fest once again proved that the city's greatest strength is its blending of many countries, becoming a vibrant community. For a few magical hours, languages blended, music crossed borders, and strangers became friends.

The work of approximately 14 schools and 19 art teachers will be represented. Without the enthusiastic cooperation of these teachers, we could not hold this event, and we thank them for their dedication to their students and to art.

The artwork will be judged by Juliana Sierra, visual artist and interior designer, Weston Art Guild member; Maria Garces Luzuriaga, visual artist, art teacher and art coach; and

Lifranco Rojas, visual artist, ACGW Director and SAS codirector. Judges will select 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place and honorable mention from these grades: Pre K-1, 2-3, 4-5, 6-8, 9-10 and 10-12. There is an added category for digital art and digital photography.

Shown are some of the entries from 2026, so you can see the quality of the work. Each year, an attendee asks, "Are these for sale?"

A reception will be held in early May for the students, their families, and the teachers, culminating the Showcase with

awards and prizes.

Article after article notes the value of the arts in promoting health and a sense of oneness among us. Laura Dobrzanski, Arts Council President, notes, "I'm delighted that the Student Artist Showcase gives our young artists a chance to share their creativity. 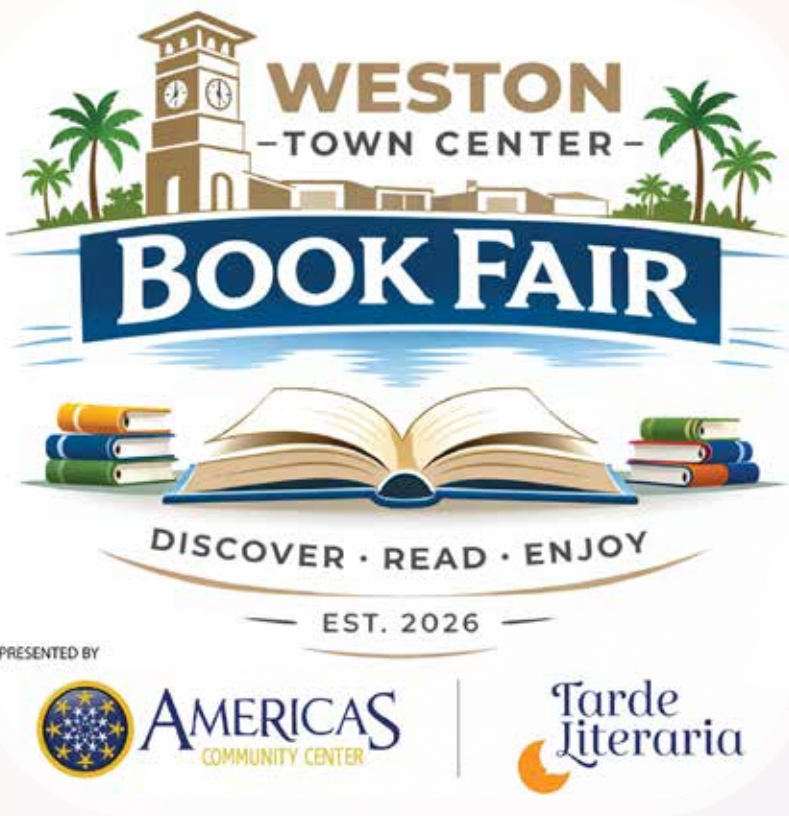

The “NO-DRAMA” Parent Conversation

3 Questions to Ask ASAP

If you’re an adult child with aging parents, you’ve probably had this thought at least once:

“If something happened... would I even know what to do?”

Not in a spooky, morbid way—more in the real-life way.

Like: Where are the documents? Who do I call? What needs to happen first?

Good news: you don’t need an hour-long “end-of-life” talk to start getting organized. You can start with three simple questions that open doors (without setting off alarms).

1) “Where do you keep important documents—and how would I find them?”

This is the question that saves families from frantic scavenger hunts later. In an emergency, you don’t want to be guessing where the will is—or whether there’s a safe deposit box key hidden in a coffee can.

Natural follow-ups (keep it practical):

Is there a safe or lockbox at home? Where’s the key?

Do you have a safe deposit box? Which bank? Who else can access it?

Where is your most recent will or trust stored?

Is there a secure master list of accounts/passwords/PINs?

2) “Who are the key people I should know how to contact?”

When something happens, it’s not the moment you want to be digging through a phone trying to find “that one banker” or “the attorney you used years ago.” A short contact list now is priceless later.

Natural follow-ups:

- Who’s your main contact at the bank or financial institution?
- Who is your attorney/estate planner?
- Who is your primary care doctor—and are you comfortable with me speaking with them if needed?
- Is there a financial advisor, accountant, or insurance agent we should include?

3) “If something happened suddenly, what would you want me to know or do first?”

This one is gentle—but powerful. It opens the door to bigger conversations (healthcare wishes, financial preferences, housing decisions) without making it feel like a formal meeting.

Natural follow-ups:

- Do you have a healthcare proxy or power of attorney set up?
- Are there bills or recurring payments that would need immediate attention?
- Is there anyone you’d want notified right away?
- What’s one thing you’d want handled exactly the way you’d handle it?

A gentle way to bring it up (without making it weird)

If you’re thinking, “My parents will shut this down immediately,” try this framing:

“Hey, I’ve been trying to get more organized about my own stuff, and it made me realize I should probably know a few basics about yours too. Mind if I ask a few quick questions?”

Most parents actually appreciate the initiative—and it rarely stays a short conversation (in a good way).

From Tragedy to Purpose

Carlos's Mission to Help Others Through Strength & Faith

Carlos came to the United States many years ago, pursuing the American dream. Like many immigrants, he worked hard, studied, and gradually built a life for himself and his family. Over time, he and his wife created a loving home, raising their children and establishing deep roots in their community. When their children eventually grew up and left home, the couple began to enjoy life as empty nesters, believing the most challenging years were behind them.

For many years, Carlos lived in Weston, where he was an active member of the community. One of his greatest passions was tennis. He spent many hours on the courts playing with friends and was part of a local tennis group called "La Tuna de Weston." Through the sport he loved, Carlos built lasting friendships and enjoyed the camaraderie of an active lifestyle.

Life, however, took an unexpected turn. During a tennis match, Carlos suffered a devastating fall that caused a severe spinal cord injury. The accident left him paralyzed

from the chest down and quadriplegic. In a single moment, everything changed—not only for Carlos, but for his entire family.

Yet in the face of unimaginable adversity, Carlos chose to transform tragedy into purpose.

Determined to inspire others navigating life-altering challenges, he wrote a book sharing his story and founded the Strength & Faith Foundation, a nonprofit organization dedicated to helping individuals with spinal cord injuries transition from rehabilitation back to life at home.

That transition is often one of the most difficult stages for patients and their families. Adjusting to new physical realities and daily routines can feel overwhelming. Carlos created the foundation to provide support during this critical time.

One initiative involves partnerships with institutions such as the Universidad Autónoma de Manizales. The goal is to bring students to the United States to assist recently injured patients and their families. Students gain cultural immersion, practice English, and learn

about advanced technology and research related to paralysis, while patients and caregivers receive valuable support.

Despite the life-changing injury, those who know Carlos describe him as joyful, positive, and deeply connected to the spinal cord injury community. He once loved playing guitar and cooking, and continues to enjoy many of the same things today—simply in a different way and at a different pace.

His focus now is serving others and bringing hope to people facing similar challenges.

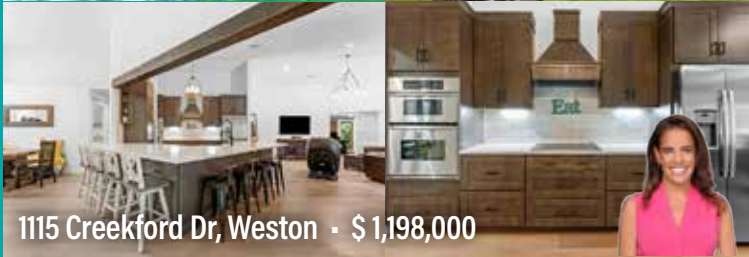

A LIFE-CHANGING MOMENT

At 22 years old, while studying art in Italy, Maria Cecilia's life changed dramatically. On July 24, 1994, she was involved in a tragic car accident that left her in a coma for three weeks. As a result of severe head trauma, she lost both her memory and her sight.

Rather than allowing this experience to define her limits, Maria Cecilia chose to redefine her possibilities.

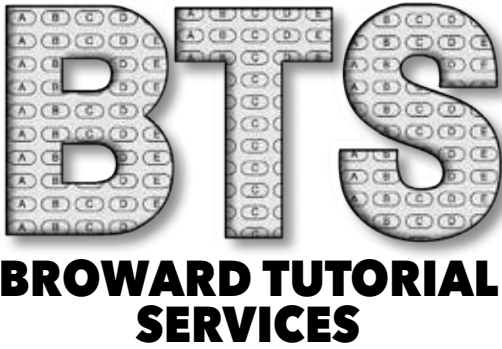

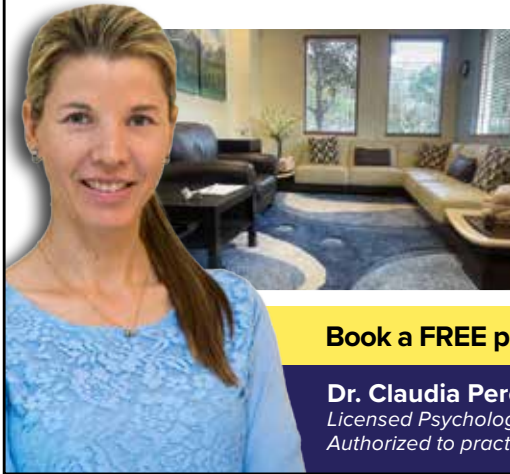

BSO'S DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

When most people think about a sheriff's office, they imagine deputies responding to emergencies, making arrests and investigating crimes. While those responsibilities are critical, a true full-service public safety organization must also address what happens after an arrest. That is where the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) Department of Community Programs (DOCP) delivers measurable results.

DOCP provides structured, accountable alternatives to incarceration that combine supervision, treatment and evidence-based intervention. This approach holds individuals responsible while targeting the root causes of repeat offending. Organized into five specialized divisions, Pretrial Services, Misdemeanor Probation, Drug Court Treatment, Juvenile Services and Reentry, DOCP provides a comprehensive continuum of care to reduce the jail population, save millions of tax dollars in incarceration costs and strengthen public safety across Broward County.

BSO's Pretrial Services and Misdemeanor Probation divisions provide court-ordered supervision for individuals in the community while maintaining accountability and protecting public safety. Established in the early 80s, the Pretrial Services Division is one of the longest-standing programs of its kind in Florida. The division supervises thousands of individuals awaiting trial under court-ordered conditions through reporting requirements, home and office visits, drug testing and, when necessary, electronic monitoring and Global Positioning System (GPS) tracking.



By stabilizing employment and preserving family ties, these strategies minimize the impact of criminal justice involvement while directly tackling the root causes of crime. Misdemeanor Probation provides supervision for individuals convicted of misdemeanor offenses through structured reporting and compliance requirements. The division also offers diversion programs for first-time offenders, typically lasting three to six months. Successful completion may result in case dismissal, reinforcing accountability while helping individuals avoid the long-term consequences of a criminal conviction.

BSO's Drug Court Treatment Division, one of the oldest programs in the nation, addresses one of the primary drivers of criminal behavior: substance use. Participants undergo intensive, court-supervised treatment that includes counseling, frequent drug testing, medication management, psychiatric services and crisis intervention. The

program also connects participants with supportive housing, transportation assistance and employment referrals. This comprehensive model reduces recidivism, decreases the risk of relapse and restores stability to individuals and families.

The Community Justice Program provides early intervention for youth, ages seven to 17, through restorative justice and structured diversion. Proactive support for youth offenders significantly lowers the likelihood of future criminal behavior, safeguarding both the individuals involved and the community.

Successful reentry is proven to be one of the most effective crime-reduction strategies available to law enforcement today. For individuals returning to the community post-incarceration, our Reentry Division provides structured supervision, employment assistance, treatment referrals and essential support services to stabilize them during a critical transition period. Through partnerships with community organizations, we host employment and resource fairs, financial literacy workshops and outreach initiatives that address housing instability and workforce barriers.

True public safety is not measured solely by the arrests we make, but by the cycles we break. Through prevention, intervention, structured supervision and successful reentry, our Department of Community Programs is breaking cycles of crime and proactively building a safer, more resilient future for all of Broward County. 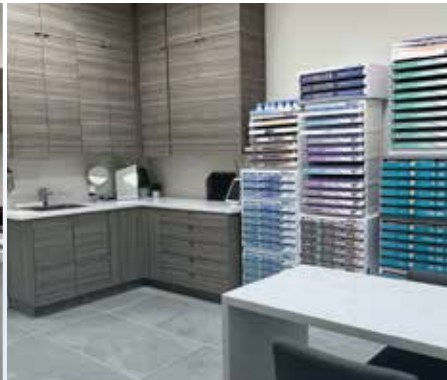

FLATFOOT IN CHILDREN

Developmental Flatfoot is one of the most common conditions affecting the musculoskeletal system of children and teenagers. There is a tendency for the child's flatfoot to be ignored or treated with benign

neglect. The facts are that it is NOT normal, the majority of children do NOT outgrow it and there IS cause for some concern. Flatfeet are a genetic problem. Ligaments in the arch which connect the bones together are loose, allowing the arch to collapse. Congenital bone abnormalities as well as trauma to the tendons and ligaments in the inner arch can cause flattening of the arch and foot. A common cause of developmental flatfoot is tightness in the calf muscles, which aggravates the severe foot deformity. Symptoms include young children constantly preferring to be carried by a parent or be put in a stroller due to fatigue in their legs. Leg pain, especially at night and premature fatigue with activity, es-

pecially in young children or teenagers. Inner leg, ankle and foot pain with activity is common. Occasionally associated with inner knee pain and lower back pain.

Signs include lowering or complete collapse of the arch. The front part of the foot is turned out relative to the back part of the foot and the arch bulges towards the inside of the ankle. Knock-Knees is common which exasperates the deformity. The feet, ankles, and legs just do not appear right upon examination or the patient is standing. The child can be overweight and lacks athletic ability, General inactivity or avoidance of activity in children is common. Abnormal shoe wear, as well as a child or teenager that does not run correctly, occurs due to the deformity

Treatment begins with a complete physical examination of the lower extremity and spine to find the underlying cause. This includes examining the child's gait (walking pattern). Physical therapy to strengthen weak muscles and loosen tight muscles and help to improve overall coordination. Occasional immobilization



of the extremity to loosen up tight muscles with a walking cast is necessary to decrease the deforming force of the calf muscle on the flatfoot. Custom molded shoe insoles (orthotics) to help permanently support the foot and put it in its proper position. In most cases this will overnight correct fatigue and leg pain that the child experiences. It will also help to allow better performance in activities of daily living or sports. In some cases when conservative treatment fails, surgery can be done to help with the problem. The appropriate treatment plan can be a life-changing experience for the child! Prognosis is excellent, especially with timely management of the problem.

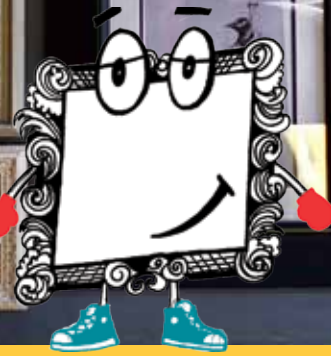
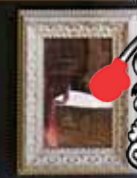

Two Invaluable Putting Tips

Putting using a name or line on your ball can really help in setting you on the correct path line. The key is to use your dominant eye so you will not struggle in correctly lining up your ball.

First, to determine your dominant eye, hold both hands out in front of you clasped together and create a small hole to look at the flag. Close one eye at a time to determine which eye is still able to see the flag. The eye that you see the flag with is your dominant eye and you will want to use that eye in lining up your ball.

If you are left eye dominant you will want to aim your ball line with your left hand. If right eye dominant, use your right hand to aim your ball line at the target. Use the same hand to increase the odds of getting the ball directly in line between your dominant eye and the target. You should now find it much easier to aim the ball directly at the target.

Once your ball is all lined up, go set up to the ball and make sure the clubface alignment matches the balls. Now you are ready to stoke it at your target. Trust your aim, begin focusing on your speed and you will become a better putter. If you are having difficulty matching your putter to the line (so it feels like you are aiming at your target), you may want to change your set-up until they match.

Check to see if your eye is directly over the ball. Think about why this is so important. When you line up to putt you want to see the direct line from the ball to the intended target. In this case, it's the hole that you are putting the ball into. Set up to putt with your normal putting stance over the ball and place a ball under your eye. Now you want to release that ball to see if it lands directly on top of the ball that you are using to putt into the hole. If the ball lands before it, you are standing too far away. If the ball lands past the ball to the right, you are standing too close. Keep trying this test to make sure your eye is directly over it with the ball always landing directly on top of it. You will be surprised how you need to make the proper adjustment to get the eye directly over the ball and see the right line that you are stroking the putter head on the same path your eyes see it.

As always, see your local teaching Professional for a putting lesson. No one knows the game better than them.

Canine Urine Marking

What is Canine Urine Marking?

Canine urine marking is a natural, instinctive behavior in dogs, but it is not appropriate inside the house. Dogs, especially sexually intact male dogs, urinate on objects to mark their territory or to leave a message for other dogs.

Urine marking behavior usually begins when the dog reaches sexual maturity.

What Causes Canine Urine Marking?

An intact male dog is most likely to mark when there is a female dog in heat nearby. Intact female dogs are also prone to marking when they are in heat. However, any dog may mark if another dog has urinated anywhere in the house. By urinating on the previous site of urination, the dog essentially “remarks” that location as its own territory. Unless the scent of the urine is completely removed, the dog is likely to keep urinating there. In multi-dog households, dogs, especially of the same sex, may compete for dominance, which can result in urine marking. This same behavior can occur in a confident dog that feels dominant to the owner.

Any anxiety-producing situation can trigger urine marking as well. Workmen in the house, the arrival of a new baby, or visiting relatives can all produce anxiety in a dog. Even the addition of a new TV or a new computer may threaten a dog so that it feels compelled to mark the packing boxes. Rest assured, your dog is not trying to get back at you. It’s just doing what comes naturally.

How Is Canine Urine Marking Diagnosed?

Your veterinarian will start by discussing when, where, and how often the behavior occurs. A workup should be conducted to rule out medical disorders that may be causing the problem. If there are no medical causes, your veterinarian will need to determine if incomplete house-training or other behavioral conditions are causing the problem.

How Can It Be Treated?

In most cases, overcoming urine marking requires multiple steps:

- **NEUTERING:** If the dog is sexually intact, neutering is the first step. In many cases, male dogs that are neutered stop urine marking within weeks to months of the procedure. Female dogs that are spayed almost always stop the behavior. However, behavior modification is often needed as well.
- **POSITIVE REINFORCEMENT:** Never punish a dog for urine marking. Punishment can create more anxiety, which may only exacerbate the problem. Instead, you need to supervise your pet closely. If you see the dog starting to eliminate inside, interrupt him or her with a firm “No,” and bring the pet outside. When the dog urinates outside, reward him or her with praise and treats. Make sure to bring your dog outside frequently, always providing rewards for appropriate urination outdoors.
- **CONFINEMENT:** During retraining, it helps to limit your dog’s access to frequently marked areas. You may need to confine your dog to a room or small area by shutting doors or by using baby gates or a crate. As your dog’s behavior improves, you can gradually increase his or her freedom in the house. Be careful to frequently exercise your dog outside, so your dog does not become agitated with long periods of confinement.
- **ESTABLISH DOMINANCE:** Some dogs need to be gently reminded that you are the boss and that they need to work for rewards. Ask your dog to sit or lay down, then provide a reward such as a treat or a walk and TLC!
- **MEDICATIONS:** As a last resort, you can consult your veterinarian for medications. In most cases, dogs are given a type of antidepressant. These drugs often take 4 to 6 weeks to make a difference. However, behavior modification is always the first choice and should continue, even with medications

APRIL IS CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH

April is Child Abuse Prevention Month, a time to reaffirm our commitment to protecting children and ensuring our child welfare system works as it should. This session, I passed HB 47: Specific Medical Diagnoses in Child Protective Investigations, to strengthen our child protection system while ensuring families are protected from wrongful child removals caused by medical misdiagnoses. HB 47 is narrow in scope and addresses a serious but specific problem – medically complex children. During committee hearings, we heard from parents whose lives were turned upside down after bringing their infants to the ER for care. Diana Sullivan brought her 11-week-old daughter to the ER for a swollen thigh. She was accused of abuse, and her infant and children, with no injuries, were removed from her care. It took her

19-months of separation from her children and paying \$300,000 in legal fees to obtain a second opinion. That second opinion confirmed that her daughter had Ehlers-Danlos syndrome, a condition referenced in the initial Child Protection Team report but not fully investigated. Sara Michler faced a similar ordeal. Wrongly accused of shaken baby syndrome, she spent 11 months and nearly \$100,000 fighting to regain custody of her child, missing irreplaceable milestones along the way. These stories highlight an important truth: medically complex children require medically informed investigations. A child wrongfully removed from a loving home suffers real harm. Certain medical conditions, including Ehlers-Danlos syndrome, osteogenesis imperfecta (brittle bone disease), rickets, and vitamin D deficiency, can cause symptoms that mimic signs of abuse. Under current procedures, when a child is found with unexplained injuries, parents

do not have a clearly defined right to seek a second medical opinion after a removal. Parents deserve that right.

HB 47 is narrow in scope and strengthens, not weakens, child protective investigations. The bill authorizes a parent or legal custodian, after a child is removed, to request a second medical opinion and establishes clear timelines for that review. It creates a structured process for addressing conflicting diagnoses and requires the Department of Children and Families to promptly request a review of relevant medical records when a qualifying condition is identified.

Child Protective Investigators play a vital role in keeping Florida's children safe. This legislation ensures that when medically complex conditions are involved, we incorporate appropriate medical expertise and due process into the process. No one should be afraid of a second opinion. Protecting children means getting it right.

■ SAFETY CORNER

WATER SAFETY

In South Florida, water is part of our everyday lives. From backyard pools to beaches, canals, and lakes, families have many opportunities to enjoy time in the water. While swimming and water play are great ways to stay active and cool off, it's important to remember that drowning can happen quickly and silently. Taking simple safety precautions can help protect your family and prevent tragedies. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, drowning is one of the leading causes of unintentional injury death for children ages 1–4 in the United States. Most child drownings occur in residential swimming pools. Because incidents can happen in seconds, layers of protection are essential.

Active supervision is the most important safety measure. Always keep a close eye on children in or near water, even if they know how to swim. Avoid distractions such as phones, conversations, or chores. The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends that adults designate a “Water Watcher”—a responsible adult whose sole job is to watch the water. If you have a home pool, consider adding multiple layers of protection to prevent unsupervised access. The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission recommends installing a four-sided fence at least four feet high that completely separates the pool from the house and yard. Self-closing, self-latching gates add another layer of protection. Additional safety layers include installing door/window alarms and pool alarms. If you have a home pool and need assistance with obtaining door/window or pool alarms, please contact the Broward Sheriff's Office Weston Fire Department at 954-389-2015. Please note that quantities are limited and obtaining these safety devices is not guaranteed.

Teach Children to Swim. Swimming lessons can help children build water competency and confidence. While swim lessons reduce drowning risk, they should always be paired with supervision and safety measures. When boating or participating in water activities, properly fitted life jackets should always be worn. This is especially important for children and inexperienced swimmers. Families should discuss basic water safety rules and emergency procedures before heading to the pool or beach. Make sure children know they should never swim alone and should always ask permission before entering the water.

Even with strong prevention measures, emergencies can still occur. Knowing CPR can make the difference between life and death in a drowning emergency. Immediate CPR can help maintain oxygen flow to the brain until professional help arrives. Your local fire department encourages families to include CPR training as part of their water safety plan. To sign up for a future CPR class, call the fire department at 954-389-2015.

By combining supervision, safety barriers, swim skills, and lifesaving training, families can enjoy South Florida's beautiful waters while keeping everyone safer.
